OVERVIEW

Corbin Glover performs as a DJ and live electric violinist simultaneously. The setup requires standard DJ equipment plus dedicated space and power for his violin rig. Please read carefully — the DJM-A9 mixer is a hard requirement due to the mic input being used for live violin processing.

DJ EQUIPMENT (PROVIDED BY VENUE)

ITEM	SPECIFICATION	NOTES
CDJ Players	Pioneer CDJ-3000 or CDJ-2000NXS2 (x2)	Either model accepted
Mixer	Pioneer DJM-A9	Hard requirement — mic input used for violin
Booth Monitors	Any quality booth monitors (x2)	1x left side, 1x right side of DJ position
Cables	All standard interconnects	RCA, XLR as needed

VIOLIN RIG (BROUGHT BY ARTIST)

Corbin brings his own electric violin and IR loader pedal. The following must be provided by the venue:

- **1x Power outlet** at DJ position for IR loader pedal
- **US plug adapter / converter** if venue is outside the United States (standard US Type A/B plug required)
- The IR pedal output connects directly into the **DJM-A9 mic input** — no additional DI box required

STAGE & SPACE REQUIREMENTS

- **Minimum 2–3 feet of clear table space** to the left of the CDJs and mixer

This space is used to safely rest the electric violin when not in play. It must remain clear at all times.

- **1x Microphone** (no stand needed) — positioned on the **right side** of the setup for crowd interaction
- Adequate space to move freely between violin and DJ position
